Meeting of BRICS Ministers of Labour and Employment
[9 June 2016 : Geneva]

The BRICS Ministers of Labour and Employment met on the sidelines of the 105th International Labour Conference on 9 June 2016 in Geneva.

The meeting reiterated commitment to achieve decent work and employment for all, strengthening intra-BRICS dialogue and exchange of experience on labour and employment issues. The BRICS Ministers agreed to work on innovation and job creation, skills development and social protection. They reaffirmed their commitment to encourage domestic industry and entrepreneurship.

India, as Chair of BRICS, will convene the next meeting of BRICS Ministers of Labour in October 2016 in India and the 1st Meeting of the BRICS Employment Working Group on 27-28 July 2016 in Hyderabad, India.

A Joint Communiqué was issued after the meeting.
